Cell Phone Photo Contest

Cell phones have greatly improved in both the quality of the built-in cameras and their capabilities over the last few years. Many of them now deliver professional-quality images. Recently, The Artistic Image has been printing several very high-quality images that came from cell phones.

The Artistic Image will have a contest and exhibition of *only* cell phone camera photos. The contest is open to anyone with a cell phone camera, and they may be in either Black and White or Color.

If your image is accepted for the show, you do **not** have to pay for printing and framing before the show. If you want the framed print it will be available to you at a greatly reduced price.

Our goal is to have an exhibition that will show the quality of prints that can be made from cell phone picture files. To achieve this, The Artistic Image will be printing each of the prints that will be on display. Each print will be printed on one of the most beautiful Fine Art papers available (Red River Palo Duro Etching) and the prints will be matted using only acid free materials. The frames will be a high-quality Neilson metal frame. Overall, this will become an exhibition that will illustrate what cell phones are capable of producing.

All regular photos will be displayed in 16x20-inch frames. If there are any Panorama images, they will be displayed in an appropriate frame size.

Each of the 16x20 framed prints will be priced for sale at \$120.00 and the Photographer will be paid \$50.00 for each of their prints that sell.

Any Photographer may purchase their framed print for \$40.00. If they want only the matted print it will be sold to them without the frame and glass for \$20.00. Any shipping charges, if necessary, will be added to the invoice.

All prints sold may be picked up at the close of the show on May 4, 2019.
